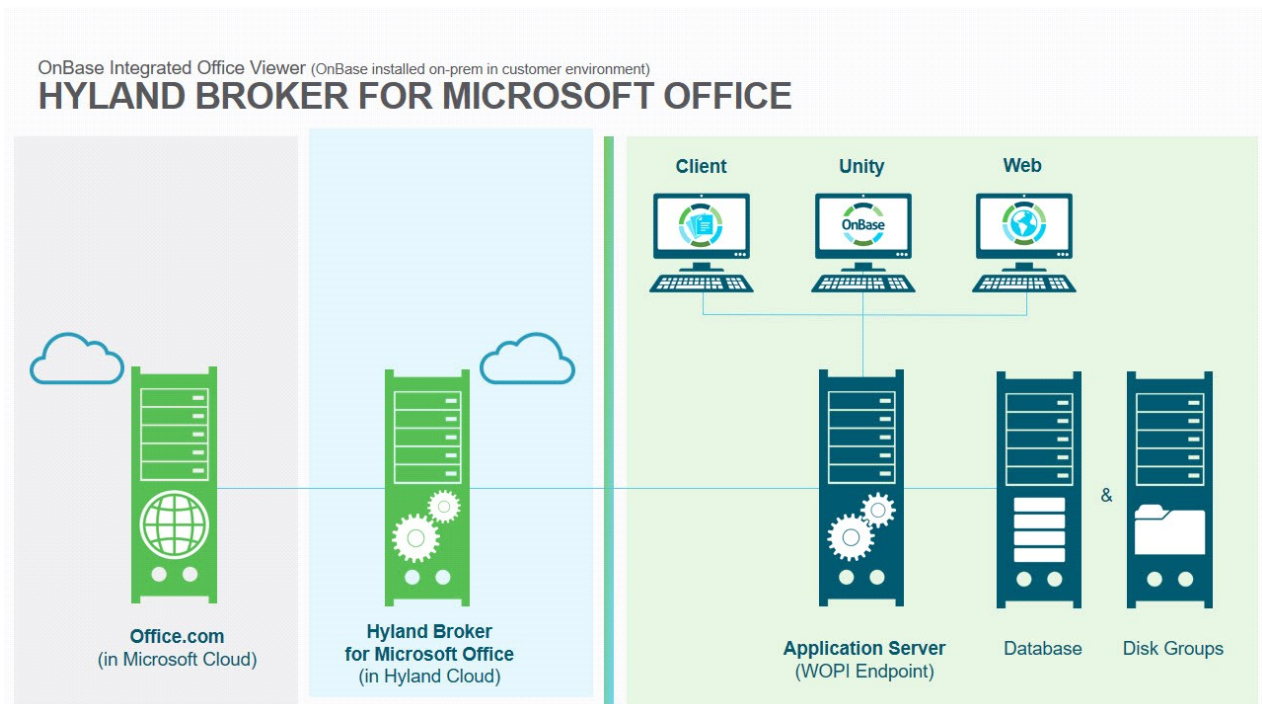
SUMMARY

The Integrated Office Viewer allows users to view, edit and co-author Microsoft Office documents stored in OnBase without the Office application installed locally on the desktop. The viewer is a native component of the OnBase Client, Web, Unity and Outlook clients—and is supported in Windows environments *and* on a Mac! It can be implemented via an on-prem installation of Microsoft's Office Online Server or Office.com (O365) via the Hyland Broker for Microsoft Office.

BENEFITS

- **Decouples OnBase from Office**, providing the flexibility to upgrade to new versions of desktop-installed software (OnBase or Office) while continuing to view, edit and co-author Office documents in OnBase
- **Eliminates Office install and version requirements**, by allowing the use of Office.com online technology to view, edit and co-author Office documents stored in OnBase without relying on the version of Office installed on the desktop
- **Improves user experience** as documents are embedded in the OnBase viewer and loaded faster
- **Provides consistency between all OnBase clients**—from the OnBase Client to Web, Unity and Outlook—when working with Office documents
- **Supports employee collaboration**, as multiple users simultaneously edit the same OnBase document (Office file formats) in a shared environment

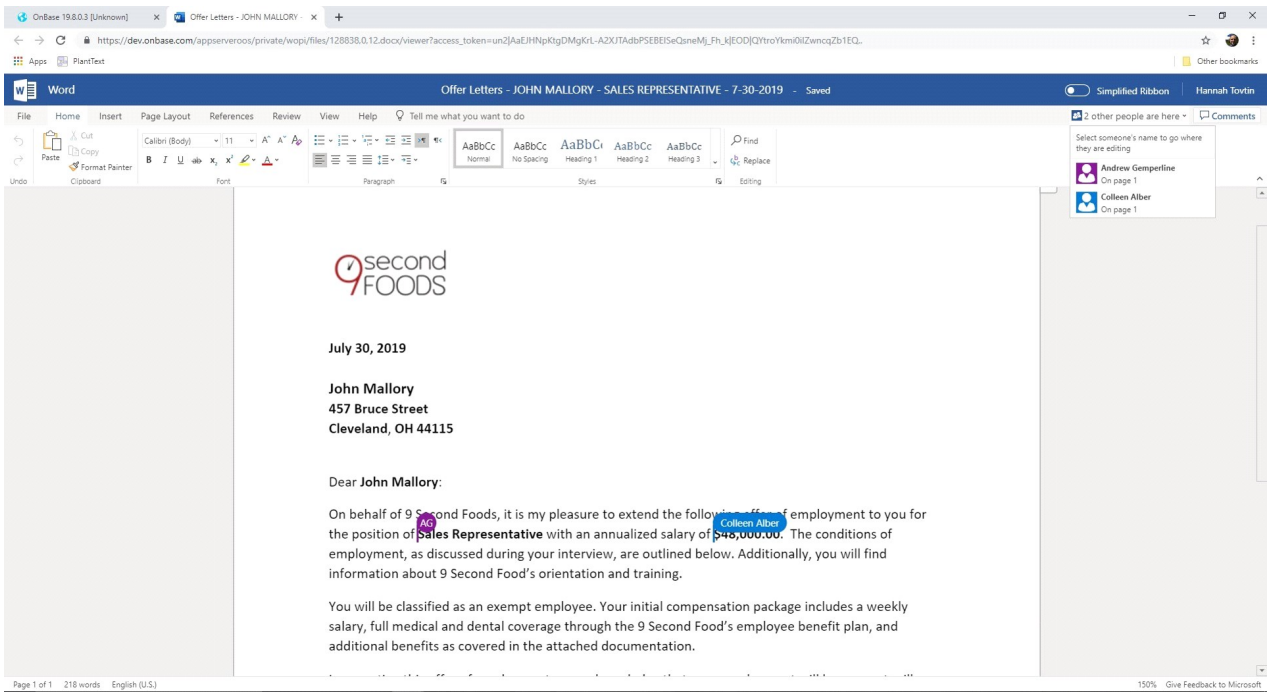
KEY FEATURES

- Multiple implementation methods support both OnBase on-prem and Hyland hosted solutions
 - Organization installs **Microsoft Office Online Server** on-premises (great for on-prem!)
 - Organization uses **Hyland Broker for Microsoft Office** service to connect OnBase to Office.com (great for on-prem & cloud!)
